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#### **OFSTED**

So, following our monitoring visit from OFSTED last term, the final report will be available on OFSTED's website from next Tuesday. Remember, this visit was just to check whether or not we are taking 'effective action' to improve the school and I am pleased to report that the inspector agrees that we are! He looked specifically at the three areas identified as needing improvement in our last report. These were:

- Leadership and management the inspector recognised that we have strengthened the
  quality of leadership, there is a strong culture of respect across the school and governors
  have a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities.
- Attendance we now have clear systems in place to reward strong attendance as well as measures to ensure that pupils are not unnecessarily absent.
- Writing because we are at the early stages of introducing Talk 4 Writing, the inspector
  acknowledged that some of the younger children are taking a bit longer to show the progress
  that is more clearly evident in the books of the older children, and that this hasn't been
  helped by unavoidable teacher absence last year and this year. However, with Mrs De Silva
  now doing great things in Dolphins, and Ms Glock building on the work that both Ms Stirk and
  then Mrs Kirwin have been doing is Seahorses, I am confident that all will be well when
  OFSTED come next time.
